

Consecrated in the Truth

Over the last few weeks in this Easter season, we have been focussing on 'love' and we were reminded last week of the love which binds the three persons of the Holy Trinity.

As we draw nearer to Pentecost, we anticipate not only the Spirit of Love but the Spirit of Truth. It was Peter who reminded the disciples as they were choosing a successor for Judas, of the fulfilment of the Old Testament scriptures in order that the truth might be revealed. It is the Holy Spirit who reminds of the past as a reinforcement of the present. We in turn are called to walk in the truth. Jesus prays to His Father that those he has chosen, unlike Judas, may remain true to his name. In today's society when it is still counter- cultural to be a follower of Christ and when we are constantly exposed to stories of those who have betrayed our trust and the trust of those who support them and believe in them...truth appears to be a forgotten commodity.

But we have the assurance that the truth is not simply something that we can acquire: It is the word of God, Jesus himself. Jesus asks not only that we may be consecrated in the truth but consecrated in Him who is the Way, the Truth, and the Life.

Let each one of us be consecrated anew in the name of the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit.
