Pentecost Sunday

This Sunday we celebrate the feast of Pentecost. We recall how the Holy Spirit came to the disciples as they prayed. The Pentecost event transformed them and gave them the power to spread God's word. It reminds us that the same Spirit is present in our lives today. We received the Holy Spirit when we were baptised, and we were sealed with the gift of the Holy Spirit in Confirmation. The Holy Spirit gives us courage, helps us remember God's presence with us, and calls us to live as witnesses of God's love.

Often a dilemma is identified when considering unity versus diversity. In the biblical story of Babel, unity was misused for self-glorification as people sought to build a tower and so be like God. However, at Pentecost, diverse languages and cultures come together under one unified purpose through the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit allows for unity in diversity, respecting individual differences while bringing people together in a common purpose, exemplified in the church and events like World Youth Day.

Our Parish, like most parishes, is richly diverse not only in terms of language and nationality, but also in terms of the abundance of gifts of the Holy Spirit we have received. We rejoice in the richness of this diversity at Pentecost because it is the Holy Spirit who creates a unity of our diversity as the body of Christ. Let us pray for ever increasing unity in diversity in our Parish as we celebrate the feast of Pentecost.
