Jesus doesn't mind if coming into our lives is coming into something of a mess. Far from it, I like to think He is well used to it, all of us have some messiness tucked away somewhere. After all, He was born in the mess of a stable and lay in the feeding trough. Once we have let Him be born in our lives, He will grow in us by the work He gives us to prepare the world for His Second Coming.

Stop the 14-day limit on experimenting on embryos being removed. The Human Fertilisation and Embryology Authority (HFEA) is pushing to remove the 14-day limit for experimenting on embryos, despite 97% of submissions from the general public to their consultation objecting to these plans.




