## Weekly Green Living Suggestions...

Significantly less than half of the waste we generate is recycled by local authorities nationally. Our authority does particularly badly although there is a new recycling facility in the pipeline, hopefully not too far into the future... Meanwhile there is a lot we can do to help. https://www.southampton.gov.uk/bins-recycling is the site to check what we can and can't currently put in our recycling bins. Southampton City Council has said that many recycling bins are 'polluted' with the wrong sort of items rendering the whole bin unviable for recycling. Eg. Currently only plastic containers shaped like bottles are acceptable. So please check!! All local authority websites will have a similar link in case you don't live in Southampton.

Our own recycling bins (at the back of the church) also need a little more care. We are having to sort through to make sure things are suitable. Eg. Items for the foil bins should be 'scrunchable'. If the pouch that looks like foil springs back after scrunching it shouldn't be in this bin! Metallic sheen flexible plastic is often ending up in the foil bin so please check, it can however be put in with flexible plastics that can be recycled in Sainsbury's. Foil should also be clean and flattened. Remember to save your stamps and wine corks too!

## Thank you **Accepting Contactless Donations!**

You will soon notice a new 'collection plate' at the back of each church, this is our new card &contactless terminal!

It's designed to make donating to the Parish (& 2nd Collections) even easier... simply tap your contactless card/phone/watch against the machine to donate, or use the chip and pin if you do not have contactless.

You can also use the machine to Gift Aid your donation - it will ask you for your details when you do, but then it will remember the card and not ask you the next time.
