Closure of Catholic Home Care

We have been carefully considering the future of Catholic Home Care over recent months and, notwithstanding our considerable sense of pride in all that has been achieved through the provision of support to the City's older people through this service, the recent departure of key staff has, with regret, led to a decision to cease operations on Friday 26 April 2024.

A number of additional factors have been taken into account in reaching this decision including a reduction in the overall number of clients, ongoing challenges in securing carer availability and the impact of the cost-of-living crisis on essential donations which have historically underpinned the financial viability of the service. It has also been recognised that the Parish does not have a sufficiently robust infrastructure to maintain the service to expected standards in the medium or long term.

All clients, service users and staff have been advised of the closure and the Parish is working with the Diocese and other agencies to ensure all those affected by the closure receive appropriate support.

Whilst the closure of Catholic Home Care brings with it a degree of sadness, we are immensely proud of the dedicated carers, service managers and volunteers who have supported so many older people to live independently in their own homes for the past 32 years. They have created an enduring legacy of care and companionship in the Parish, and their experience will undoubtedly help shape and inform the Parish's community outreach and social action activities in the future.
