Fourth Sunday of Lent

Those preparing for baptism at Easter celebrate the scrutinies this Sunday at the 10am Mass at St Joseph's. Lent for them, and for us who have been baptised, is a time to carefully scrutinise our lives. We undertake this self-reflection to identify the presence of sin, turn to God in repentance and receive God's forgiveness in confession. What a great gift it is to have the gift of God's forgiveness available to us when we fall short in living out our life in Christ established in baptism. At our Sunday Masses (other than the 10am Mass) we will hear about a man called Nicodemus who comes to Jesus

by night. He is not quite able to step into the light and he could not fully understand Jesus or his message. However, he continued to grapple with his misunderstanding and defended Jesus at his trial. Later he would anoint the dead body of Jesus. In this last act of homage, Nicodemus embraced Jesus as King, thereby becoming his disciple.

To believe in Jesus means more than accepting an idea; it involves a transformative trust in the sacrifice of God's only Son, leading to being born again and obtaining eternal life. Nicodemus's final act of faith is a reminder that even if one begins the Christian journey half-heartedly, what matters in the end is the ultimate giving of one's life and destiny to Christ. This act of faith is not just acknowledging sin but seeing it overcome by God's mercy, leading to salvation and a new life in Christ.
