It was said, allegedly by Andy Warhol, that we are all destined for 15 minutes of fame. Whether he said this or not, there certainly is a frequently met desire across society for fame or individualism.

It is good for one's individual qualities, one's personal charisms, to be recognised and celebrated. But it is also important to be part of something much larger and beyond oneself. We are made in the image of God, and as soon as God had created one individual He created another, to live with each other and to mutually coexist in harmony. When our words or actions impinge on the wellbeing of others we set ourselves apart.

To restore that harmony and mutuality, to rebuild that unifying sense of community, Jesus reminds us this week in our Gospel reading of our need to respond, patiently encouraging the one who has strayed to come back home.

Throughout Mass, we express our sense of community, we say together the Confiteor recognising our individual shortcomings and seeking restoration with one another and with God; the Eucharistic Prayer reminds us that as a people we are ceaselessly gathered together to God; we pray together for the needs of others and ourselves; and so it goes on.

We might want, however, to nourish that sense of community, outside of the Mass and to find comfort, solace, nourishment, and pleasure in company with others through some community group. Participating in groups not only affords us individually with these things but facilitates us in building up others.

Over the summer we have had displays posted around our parish churches offering an indication of just some of our groups. In church parlance, they are called ecclesial communities, but the naming is far less important than the doing. Across the parish there are a plethora of groups, far too many to list here, and if none of them appeals, then suggest one and form it with others. There is no end of support for such initiatives. Dare I write this, but only coming to Mass is not quite enough?

What's going on?

INSIGHT This insight course will be directed by the Verbum Dei Community, Southampton, with the support of the Senior Leadership Team for the Catholic City Centre Parish of St Joseph's and St Edmund's in Southampton.

The aim of the course: The course is designed to build new capable leaders (apostles) from within the parish. It will focus on leadership through service by expanding the skills and perspectives of the current leaders' team and developing new leaders from the diverse parish community.

The structure of the course: The course will be given in face-to-face mode. The target audience will be current group leaders in the Parish, potential and new leaders (from post university singles, to married couples, and retirees). We are hoping to attract new leaders with many different skills and backgrounds.

It will be delivered in three different blocks of sessions throughout the year:

- ~ October-December (Christmas and New Year break)
- ~ January-March (Easter Break)
- ~ April-June.

The sessions will be every other week on Thursdays at SO16 3GE, 33 Elmsleigh Gardens, from 7.00pm to 8.30 with snacks, coffees and teas.
