# Now is the time to be that voice and to act!

Cop 28, The United Nations Climate Change Summit began last week in the United Arab Emirates. It gathers at the end of a year that has seen climate disasters affecting communities worldwide. There have been forest fires forcing people to flee their homes in the Mediterranean, floods that have killed thousands in Libya and droughts in East Africa depriving tens of millions of people access to food. Pope Francis has warned that these disasters are demonstrating that the crisis is reaching breaking point.

The UK is one of the largest historic emitters of greenhouse gases driving the climate crisis.

This Sunday's readings for the Second week in Advent could not be more appropriate and relevant as a wakeup call to us all. The prophet Isaiah foretells the coming of John the Baptist who will cry out from the wilderness "Prepare a way for the Lord'. We have created that wilderness by our desecration of the planet that God gave us. We are running out of time.

Pope Francis and world leaders are calling the world: to consign fossil fuels to history and stop all new oil, coal and gas production; to finance the loss and damage fund, supporting all low-income countries suffering from the impacts of climate catastrophes and to support small scale farmers who are growing foods in ways that protect nature rather than harm it.

These messages are all consistent with the tenets of Catholic Social teaching: solidarity, subsidiarity, preferential option for the poor and stewardship of God's creation.

Advent is the time for new beginnings. We are getting closer and closer to the "day of the Lord," a term which the authors of the Christian Scriptures carried over from the Hebrew Scriptures. But we cannot sit back and do nothing. We are all called to be that voice.

Cafod encourages us to share Pope Francis' message with our MPs and support local protests and action, and most importantly to pray.

God of blessings, the universe sings of your glory.

Deepen our gratitude for all you have made
and awaken in us a renewed commitment
to care for the earth and each other.
Inspire world leaders at COP28,
with openness to listen to those most affected by climate change
and with courage to act urgently and wisely,
so that our common home may be healed and restored
and all people, and generations to come, may delight in it.
Amen.
