Ash Wednesday is this Wednesday! Masses are St Ed's 6:30, 10am, 7pm, and in St Joseph's at 12:15pm

Ash Wednesday is a day of Fast and Abstinence. The law of fasting requires Catholics between the ages of 18 and 60 to eat only one full meal a day, as well as two smaller meals. The two smaller meals together should not equal a full meal. Catholics over the age of 14 are expected to abstain from eating meat on Ash Wednesday and all Fridays through the Lenten season.

Remaining inside the camp

Driving around Manila, I never found it difficult to spot the gated communities - those living inside kept others out and themselves in. They are harder to spot in the UK, but they are still here. Living in this way highlights that there are those who have and those who do not. But gated communities are simply one way of segregation, whilst at some point in their lives eg shopping, travelling, etc, they will have to intermingle.

It is very easy to look down on other people because they may be different from us when in fact those differences are minor and do not matter. There will always be those who for one reason or another, and through no fault of theirs, are different. At this point I remind myself the Mass starts with our collective praying of the *Confiteor*. Today is as good as any to recognise that each of us is in need of healing which comes from Jesus the Christ.

Rather than exclude those from the 'camp' who may not be like us, we invite them in to share the joys and the life God gives us in Jesus. Jesus did not hesitate to heal the leper who came pleading for help. So, too, we receive that healing from whatever may cause us to be separated from God.

Today, let's pray for healing of those situations that continue to exclude people. As Christians, let's invite people to be part of God's human community as Christ did with everyone He met. Jesus healed the leper and brought him back into the community, may we in our own way allow Jesus to bring healing to our lives so that we can bring healing to those who are desperately in need.
