A Change of Tone

Have you seen your first Christmas advert yet? Or heard anyone talking about Christmas cards and presents? Or seen the Christmas decorations in the shops? Already the rush of Christmas is upon us, the tones from our everyday lives have changed into the theme of Christmas. The tones of our readings this Sunday also have a change of tone, the focus is about preparation. Not just preparation of presents but a spiritual preparation. In the past weeks Jesus has been dealing with the Pharisees and others trying to trick Him by asking Him questions. However, whilst Christmas may be approaching for us, in this part of this Sundays Gospel the cross is rapidly approaching our Blessed Lord. Jesus is trying to get a message out to His disciples, the ones who will continue the mission of spreading the good news after His resurrection, it would be no good if they didn't know what to say. Jesus is making sure they are awake. Physically awake, spiritually awake, mentally awake. If they are not prepared and fall asleep, this will lead to panic.

Jesus is encouraging us to be prepared. Not just for Christmas where we will welcome Him into the crib but also be prepared when He will welcome us into Heaven. Between now and Christmas we can begin to ask the question: am I awake? Am I spiritually awake? Am I awake to what God is asking of me? Am I awake to the gifts that He has given to me? We can be so good at preparing for others, especially at Christmas time so maybe this is a time we can prepare for Jesus.



Livestreaming Mass Problems. Unfortunately at St Joseph's we have had a problem with the system from October onwards which we can't seem to rectify. The parish also received note this week of a planned monthly bill for the WiFi totalling £300+ a month. Our finances are such that we cannot consider meeting such a bill. This issue combined with the fault in the system has prompted us to withdraw streaming of Masses in St Joseph's for the time being. We plan to revisit this decision in the Spring.

GDPR and Safeguarding policies are guiding our decisions to review the timetable of Masses streamed. Going forward we plan to stream the 11am Mass in St Edmund's on a Sunday.



Mark's gospel has just that kind of momentum, and this performance gives a memorably strong sense of it."
