Journeying in the Boat

 We live in a world where strength is often measured in terms of huge forces, big numbers, the power to dominate others and so forth. Joseph Stalin was once
cautioned by Winston Churchill to give weight to the Pope's opinion in world affairs.
Stalin was at the height of his power, and sarcastically asked how many divisions the Pope had. A few decades later, the seemingly unthinkable happened: the mighty
Soviet Empire collapsed, thanks in no small part to the moral leadership of Wojtyła, Pope St John Paul II.

Today we read how Elijah has fled to the holy mountain, Horeb, reputably Mount Sinai. This is where the 10 commandments, amidst thunder and lightning, were given to Moses, a place of encounter between God and His people, yet God manifests Himself to Elijah in a tiny, whispering sound. This is God who is all powerful and at the same time insignificant and weak, all because He loves us just as He loved the Prophet Elijah.

The Word of God on this Sunday challenges the worldly notion of greatness. It teaches us that God reveals Himself to us in powerlessness and invites us to a new way of living and relating. We must be prepared to let go of our desire to be in control and accept the way of God with humility and courage.

Our Gospel introduces Peter receiving an important lesson on Lake Galilee. It was not physical strength, alpha-male bravado nor capability that he needed but the strength of faith, trust and surrender. It was strength in gentleness and vulnerability that would see him through. He and his fellow disciples must discard any notion of power to dominate, and follow Jesus in His way of trusting in God and acting in complete powerlessness.

No matter what happens in our lives, no matter how hopeless it seems, when we think God is far away by reason of sickness or illness, or straightforward fear and desperation, when we begin to doubt ourselves and the people around us; this is the time that we accompany Jesus, who walks across water to put us back into the boat with Peter. Getting back in to that boat and resuming our journey takes us home to the Father and thereby live forever in the presence of Jesus the Christ.

URGENT Gift Aid Forms (UPDATED...)

All gift aiders to the parish **must please send a new Gift Aid Declaration as soon as possible** to the Parish Office. As the Diocese has changed to the Catholic Diocese of Portsmouth we have been asked to fill in new forms under the new name. If you have changed address or have a new name you must also fill in a new form. Forms are available at the back of church or can be posted / emailed from the Office if requested.

Our current claim (money received January - June) pending submission will drop if we have to remove those donors whose forms we're still waiting to receive.

How can I donate to the parish so they can identify me as a gift aider? As long as we have your gift aid form all donations you make (that we can identify!) we claim on:

- **Standing Orders** with the donor's name are the easiest way for the Parish to identify gift aiders, and the reliable predictable income helps the parish to budget.
- **Bank Transfers** are equally easy to match to a gift aider
- Cheques made payable to CDP SOUJE

Can the parish claim on the cash donations put in the collection? No! Any gift aiders who are putting cash in the collection basket, sadly we cannot claim gift aid on your donations any longer. We do not have enough counters to reinstate the gift aid envelopes and so we are asking all those who donate via cash to consider bringing the cash to the office instead, where it can be claimed on, or donating in other ways (standing order etc).

Cash must be in an envelope marked with your name, or can be brought directly into the Parish Office.

Contactless Machines take care of the gift aid forms automatically once you donate (if you donate to the parish by ways other than the contactless machine, you will still need to fill in a new gift aid form for us to claim on that).
