Seeing Jesus in how he reveals himself

"Touch me and see for yourselves; a ghost has no flesh and bones as you can see I have." The Resurrection of Jesus is central to Christian belief. The beginning of this Sunday's Gospel, just as last Sunday, is still Easter Sunday although on the road to Emmaus. Encountering Jesus is about recognising God's love living among us. Maybe like these two disciples, we are all on a journey to meet Jesus. It is Jesus who comes to us in our deepest moment of need and gives us hope to face another day. Even as Jesus walked alongside the disciples, something still blocked their eyes from recognising him.

Oftentimes, when we are searching for Jesus, we want to see him as we imagine him. However, we are called to see Jesus not in how we choose to see him, but in how he reveals himself - in the poor, the hungry, and the outcast. Jesus reveals himself as food for our journey, whether on the road to Emmaus, on the altar at Mass, or elsewhere.

Once we allow ourselves to recognise Jesus, we are compelled to go out and share the "Good News" with the entire world. This season of Easter gives us the opportunity to focus on how we can recognise the Christ throughout our lives. We find Jesus in the Eucharist; in the people gathered; in the stories of his life that keep his memory fresh and available to us daily; and importantly when we open our eyes and see more clearly in the people yet to be gathered at the table.

The Vatican's Dicastery for the Doctrine of the Faith issued an important Declaration called *Dignitas Infinita*,

which condemns some of the grave violations of human dignity in today's world. You can read the document. https://www.vatican.va/roman_curia/congregations/cfaith/documents/rc_ddf_doc_20240402_dignitas-infinita_en.html

In the 'non-exhaustive' list that is offered, abortion, euthanasia and surrogate motherhood are listed as violations of human dignity alongside war, poverty and human trafficking. The text contributes to overcoming the dichotomy that exists between those who focus exclusively on beginning-and-end-of-life issues, while forgetting so many other attacks against human dignity and, conversely, those who focus only on defending the poor and migrants while forgetting that life must be defended from conception to its natural conclusion.
