A Pure Heart Create for Me O God

Ash Wednesday seems a long time ago and we find ourselves in the second half of Lent. The beautiful Responsorial Psalm this Sunday is the Miserere and the most famous of the seven penitential psalms. It asks that hearts be changed, that sins be forgiven, and that strength to walk according to the Lord's commands be given. It is thought to be a direct composition of King David. The powerful King of Israel is brought to his knees in abject sorrow for his sins. He takes full and personal responsibility. There are no excuses.

Verse 5, "a sinner was I conceived" is what the Church has traditional called "original sin." Thanks to Christ's redeeming sacrifice, whose benefits are bestowed upon us in Baptism, we become filii in Filio (sons and daughters in the Son). However, there is still that residual damage called "concupiscence" - the propensity to sin. We carry around with us the baggage of concupiscence which tilts us in the direction of sin, but we are still essentially good, and under the impulse of divine grace, we can do the good we intend.

The psalmist king prays for a "clean heart", a gift that was ours on the day of our Baptism. Only divine or sanctifying grace can grant us a clean heart. This grace is available to us in the Sacrament of Confession. Pray the words of the Miserere (Psalm 50/1) in preparation for the sacrament before Easter.
