

How Influential Am I?

"The life and death of each of us has its influence on others". This is from St. Paul, in our second reading today and the word that struck me was "influence". Throughout my life I have constantly been influenced by those around me. From a young age with my family, growing up in Portsmouth. Or when I started going to church when I was nine and the priest first spoke to me about my faith. A little further on in my life I was a builder which was a completely different experience of influencers. However, all these experiences and people have led me to this moment. I was ordained to the Priesthood in July, and I am now serving as an assistant priest in Southampton.

Here are three questions I want to ask, because these three things have been influential in my life:

- 1. Do you laugh? Six years in a Seminary, in Birmingham were very happy times for me. However, just like any other walk of life there were those difficult days. However, it is the laughter that I remember most. Nearly every day we laughed at silly things.
- 2. Are you welcoming? Every day since I have arrived in Southampton, I have been welcomed by someone. Going into a new place can be overwhelming for anyone. I have been made to feel welcome and this influence can be so powerful for anyone who walks through the doors of our Churches.
- 3. Do you pray? We all have busy lives. I have found it very difficult coming out of the seminary and finding a rhythm of prayer. However, prayer shapes our lives, it moulds us into what God wants us to be. Furthermore, prayer can help influence others.

I am very grateful for the welcome, prayers and laughter that you have all given to me. I am praying for you all every day, please pray for me.

INSIGHT This insight course will be directed by the Verbum Dei Community, Southampton, with the support of the Senior Leadership Team for the Catholic City Centre Parish of St Joseph's and St Edmund's in Southampton.

The aim of the course: The course is designed to build new capable leaders (apostles) from within the parish. It will focus on leadership through service by expanding the skills and perspectives of the current leaders' team and developing new leaders from the diverse parish community.

The structure of the course: The course will be given in face-to-face mode. The target audience will be current group leaders in the Parish, potential and new leaders (from post university singles, to married couples, and retirees). We are hoping to attract new leaders with many different skills and backgrounds.

It will be delivered in three different blocks of sessions throughout the year:

- ~ October-December (Christmas and New Year break)
- ~ January-March (Easter Break)
- ~ April-June.

The sessions will be every other week on Thursdays at SO16 3GE, 33 Elmsleigh Gardens, from 7.00pm to 8.30 with snacks, coffees and teas.
