Gaudete Sunday!

Christmas is almost here but we are not there yet.

These first few weeks of Advent has been a time of contemplating our relationship with God and perhaps renewing our relationship with Him. However, we can forget one key word in our Catholic vocabulary which is "rejoice".

Today, the Church celebrates Gaudete Sunday, 'Gaudete' meaning rejoice.

This is still a time of reflection and conversion, but this is also a time, as
Pope Francis says, to "think of all the good things life has given you".

On the Advent wreath there are five candles. White, which represents
Christmas day. Three Purple ones which represent hope, peace, and love.

There is also a pink candle which represents joy. Purple is the colour of advent, which promotes more of a penitential season; the pink is a reminder of joy. Whilst this is a time of reflection and a time of growth in our spiritual life, today is also a day of joy.

What should we be joyful about? Maybe it is something that has happened this year. Maybe it is something that is happening right now. Maybe there is something to look forward to in the future. Advent is a time to think of Christ in the past, present and future: Jesus coming to us in the manger, Jesus with us now in our everyday lives and situations, and Jesus when He will come again at the end of time. These are three reasons we can be joyful. St Paul writes in our second reading today that we should be always happy; pray constantly; and for all things give thanks to God. These things may seem impossible at times but when we see that Christ is present at all these times in our lives it suddenly seems possible.
