Questions to Ponder for the Week...

1. What risk did the Canaanite woman take when she cried, *"Have pity on me, Lord, Son of David!"* (Gospel). Who are the risk takers today? For the environment? For racial justice? For peace in Ukraine? For caring for people? For the Health Service? Is anything great gained without risk?

2. "For My house shall be called a house of prayer for all the peoples" (1st reading). Is God's house open to just a few people or all people? Did the chosen people have to wrestle with that idea? Today, does racial, or any other bias, relate to this problem? What is the message in this reading—to go find the excluded and bring them in?

3. St Paul, in our 2nd reading, says that the Israelites disobeyed yet received mercy; the Gentiles disobeyed and received it too. Mercy is a profound characteristic of God. Homework: trace Jesus' mercy in today's Gospel to the Canaanite woman.

Pope's Prayer Intention for August For World Youth Day


We pray the World Youth Day in Lisbon will help young people to live and witness the Gospel in their own lives.

If you did not fill in a Gift Aid Declaration after 1st January 2023 then you must fill in a new gift aid declaration form to return to the Parish as soon as possible. Equally, if you have changed address or have a new name since you last filled in your form then you must also fill in a new form.

Forms are available at the back of church or can be posted / emailed from the Office if requested.

Our current claim (money received January - June) pending submission will drop if we have to remove those donors whose forms we're still waiting to receive.

What can the Parish claim Gift Aid on?

Due to a change in Auditing Standards we can no longer claim Gift Aid on third party collections (e.g. CAFOD).
