The Word of God

Pope Francis has dedicated the third Sunday of Ordinary Time to the Word of God. As St Jerome famously said, "Ignorance of scripture is ignorance of Christ". What does the scripture mean to us? How should we read it?

As of today, I am taking up the challenge of the Bible in a Year Podcast, by Fr Mike Schmitz. This is one way of getting to know the scripture. There are so many other ways. There are daily readings at mass which carry a structure and a theme to them. Perhaps before we come to mass we could read the readings in advance because, to read it oneself and then hear it from another, are different ways of experiencing the written word. We must be people who read the scripture, who listen to it but also be people who live it. Jesus in the gospel today was gathering His new disciples and giving them a new mission. The Bible is a great way that God calls us, each of us, to our own mission.
