Pilgrimages

- 1. In September and October this year, the relics of St Bernadette will journey on pilgrimage to England, Scotland, and Wales for the very first time. This very special once in a lifetime event will provide an opportunity for people of all ages and backgrounds to experience the special gifts and charisms of Lourdes, in a church or cathedral near them. Our Portsmouth Cathedral (St John's) will be our closest venue, and they have advised we book as it is predicted to be busy! To register please see https://stbernadette.org.uk/registration/ Slots go from 9.30am on Thursday 8th September to 10am on Friday 9th September in 15 minute intervals.
- 2. A visit/pilgrimage to Portugal culminating in Fatima: 12th-19th October. In Lisbon we visit the birthplace of St Anthony where we will celebrate Mass and visit the museum dedicated to his life. We then visit Pastes de Belem and the Cathedral which dates from the 12th Century. On Saturday we depart for Fatima via Sintra. In Fatima we will visit all the important sites and participate in the evening candle light procession. The cost is £895 (sharing) which includes breakfast & evening meals (except for one fish lunch), pilgrims are responsible for lunch if desired.
