YOU WILL NOT BE ABLE TO GAIN ACCESS TO ST JOSEPH WITHOUT THE NEW KEY FROM NEXT WEEKEND

Of the 30 keys we estimate to have given out over the years, only 7 people have informed me they have a key and come to collect the new one! This obviously leaves a large number of people who have yet to get in touch and change their keys... **please please do get in touch!**

The Brown Door keys at St Joseph's have been changed!

We are trying to come up with a full list of key holders and so are asking that everyone with a key returns the key to a member of the clergy (or the office) **this week!!!**. If you could put your name with the key on/in an envelope then we can match up who needs the new keys. **If you need your key returned before the 27th July then just call Anna to say you have the key.** The new lock will be used from the weekend of the 29th July and so if you have not returned your old key you won't be able to get in the building!!!!

The Organ in St Edmund's needs to be replaced as it is beyond affordable repair. Bryn and Keith are keeping it chugging along. But the time is coming when it will no longer be usable, and a conservative estimate is that it would cost £250,000 to repair (possibly thousands more). So we are looking at an alternative solution using a 'digital' organ, costing in the region of £30-£40,000! We are having our first retiring collection for the Organ next weekend, please give generously if you can.
