Do you need to use a Yellow Envelope for the priests' collection? The Yellow Envelopes will be available at the back of each church this weekend. If you are a gift aider you can donate via the contactless machines, online, via bank transfer (ref priest) or by using the yellow envelopes with your information filled in. If you are not a gift aider you do not need to use one.

Parking Updates Southampton Churches have been in communication with the Council, particularly on the subject of 'flexing' the new parking times - aiming for an 11am start to charges instead of 8am. Whether we will be successful remains to be seen, but the plan is to at least review in six months' time. They have asked that we churches keep track of the impact of the charges on our congregations so that we can demonstrate any negative consequences in March. Any evidence we can produce will strengthen the case when taking any amendments before the full council.

The key challenges that the city is facing at the moment are that our finances are extremely vulnerable and we have an extremely high rate of domestic abuse which is creating a huge pressure on children's services and the need to find more foster parents. The council have asked if we churches could help find more foster carers.

Would you consider fostering? Foster carers provide safe and loving homes for children who can't live with their birth families at the current time. The children are from a wide variety of backgrounds and all have different reasons for being in care. Sometimes children stay with foster carers for a few days, and some stay for a few years, but the difference a foster carer makes, may last a lifetime.
