

Second Sunday of Lent

The Gospel at Mass on Ash Wednesday identified prayer as having particular importance in the Christian life. Prayer is spending time with Jesus as we would spend time with a friend. Prayer deepens our faith and strengthens our friendship with Jesus. In Lent we are invited to walk with him as he takes up his cross and we are called by him to take up ours. Prayer helps us to carry the cross.

We can pray anywhere and at any time, and we should endeavour to take opportunities to pray as they present themselves in daily life. On a mountaintop, accompanied by Peter, James and John, Jesus is transfigured, and the voice of the Father reveals His identity, "This is my Son, the Beloved. Listen to Him" (Mk 9:7). When we pray, we too are transfigured and we are given a glimpse of future glory, the glory of heaven.

The prayer of adoration of Our Lord Jesus Christ truly present in the Eucharist is of inestimable value to us. It was a great joy to experience the families involved in First Holy Communion preparation adoring the Lord's Real Presence with great faith and reverence recently. Consider committing yourself to one hour with Our Lord in the Eucharist each week. We will be reminded of the Lord's words on Holy Thursday to His disciples, "Could you not keep watch with me for one hour?" (Mt 26:40). Could you commit to spending an hour with Jesus in the Eucharist each week?
