

MORE THAN A NAME, IT IS WHO WE ARE

When I was 7 years old, my mum told me the story behind my unusual name - JOHNPROMISE. My mum looked forward to my delivery as her 3rd child; unfortunately, I was sickly from birth and after so many weeks in the hospital and lots of treatments, the doctors advised my parents to take me home and prepare for the inevitable – death. My parents brought me home and prayed God to let me live. My mum promised to offer me to God as His servant if He spares me from dying. After three months of treatments and sleepless nights, that little child was miraculously healed, and my mum who is a convert from the Church of England, vowed to name me PROMISE – meaning the promised child that survived all odds. On the day of my Baptism at the Cathedral Church of Christ the King, Aba, Nigeria, the catechist asked my parents what name they had given me, and they shouted proudly – PROMISE. The catechist was surprised and reminded them that Catholics do not go by such names; however, if they wanted to retain the name PROMISE, they must attach it to the name of a well-known saint in the Catholic Church. My mum who was devoted to St John the Beloved (Disciple of Jesus), took that John and attached it to PROMISE, hence my unusual name – JOHNPROMISE. It is a name I am very proud to bear. It is a name I cling to in times of turbulence and the vicissitudes of life. It is who I am!

In the readings of this Sunday, we encounter the powerful significance of names which carries with it the magnitude of who we are, and the enormous responsibilities placed on our shoulders. In our First Reading, the Lord demoted Shebna (Vigour) from office due to his highhandedness and promoted Eliakim (God Establishes/God Sets up), so he could be a father to all Israelites be they of the House of Judah or the House of David. In today's Gospel, Peter affirmed Jesus to be – **Ho****Christos*, ho Huios tou Theou tou zontos** – The Christ, the Son of the Living God. By affirming Christ (Christos**) as the Messiah/Anointed One, Peter ended the long speculation of who the Messiah might be and when He might appear. Christ in return affirmed Peter (Petros** – Rock/Stone) as the visible foundation/leader of His Church. My friends, none of us an accident, we are all created in the image and likeness of God; this comes out palpably in the names we bear. Have we discovered the true meaning of our names and the awesome responsibilities that go with them? Have a go today and we will discover how rich the depths of God are and how deep His wisdom and knowledge are on every one of us.

After 2 years of service here in City Centre Parish Southampton, today is my last Sunday; IT'S TIME TO SAY GOODBYE. I have had an amazing 2 years with you all. Thank you Mgr Vincent for putting up with me and allowing me to flourish. Thank you all for praying, accommodating, and supporting me. Thank you all for being so patient. Thank you all for being wonderful people. If I wronged you in any way, do forgive me, please. Pray for me to become that Promised Parish Priest of Fleet and Church Crookham, who is very welcoming, loving, merciful, supportive, and inclusive. Do come around and see me whenever you are on your way to London. I love you all and I will miss you all. KEEP SMILING! KEEP BEING GORGEOUS! KEEP BEING FABULOUS!!!

We have not been able to offer in person safeguarding training since before COVID, we have been using Educare online which some people don't find easy to use.

We are hoping to offer in person training Saturday 9th September in St Edmund's Hall

We need at least **twelve** people to attend the Child Exploitation and at least seven people to attend Vulnerable Adult Training. If we don't have these numbers by 5th September we will have to cancel (only 3 confirmed so far!).

For some ministries in the church this training is mandatory - like CLOW - but for others it is an optional extra - like RCIA. The training is required on a regular basis, so your training may have expired - if unsure check with me!

Child Exploitation Training: Children's Liturgy Team, FHC catechists, Confirmation catechists... etc Vulnerable Adult Training: Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion who visit the Housebound, RCIA catechists, volunteer drivers... etc
