- 3. Christ's innocence and lack of vengeance (2nd reading) show us what God's love is like. Where do you find strength to endure your own suffering? How can suffering be an occasion of grace? Was the pandemic an occasion of some graces for you?

Demands on the Parish Office have, for some reason, increased of late. We are looking at ways of dealing with this without 'breaking the back' of those in the Office. As a temporary measure we are going to close St Edmund's Church on a Monday; also only have the Parish Office open for visitors on a Tuesday (10am-5pm); this is not intended to be permanent but until a better solution is found. Bear with us!

On Wednesday (3rd May) the Polish Community are celebrating the 70th Anniversary of the establishment of the 'Polish Chaplaincy' with a social in the afternoon and a Mass in the evening. Congratulations to the Polish Community......and good to have you with us!

Next Saturday sees the **Coronation of King Charles** in Westminster Abbey. We pray for him and the role and responsibility he takes on in the United Kingdom and beyond. As recommended by the Bishops' Conference we will celebrate the 7pm Mass on Friday for him (see elsewhere for a prayer).

At present the limited numbers of parish counters means that counting the weekly cash collections take a very long time! One way around this, is by **promoting other ways of donating** - like via standing orders or bank transfers to the Parish bank account. Donating this way relieves pressure on the parish, but we of course understand if this is not something you are able to do.

If you would like to donate to Second Collections via a bank transfer please put the initials of the charity or the cause as the name. This allows me to allocate accordingly.

However, if you would like to give via a monthly standing order, then I will provide you with a 2023 collection calendar for you to look through and identify which collections you would like to donate to. If you already give via SO to the Parish you can simply adjust the amount to include what you wish to give or set up another SO. If you don't give to the parish via SO but would like to for second collections, you can simply set up a SO for this.
