# Third Sunday of Lent

Five adults are preparing for baptism, confirmation and eucharist (sacraments of initiation) at Easter. The process of initiation is known as the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults). For the five, known as the elect since the Rite of Election at the Cathedral on the Saturday following Ash Wednesday, Lent is a period of purification and enlightenment. In Lent we are all reminded of baptism already received or the preparation for its reception which renews the entire community to celebrate the paschal mystery of the Lord's death and resurrection.

Scrutinies are celebrated on the third (11am Mass), fourth (10am Mass), and fifth (7pm Mass) Sundays of Lent. They are rites of self-searching and repentance that are meant to uncover and then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect and to strengthen all that is good. The scrutinies are celebrated to deliver the elect from the power of sin and Satan, to protect them against temptation and to give them strength in Christ. Lent for all the baptised, not just for the elect, is a time for serious examination of life and true repentance. We can all grow and receive new strength in our spiritual life and open our hearts to receive more fully the gifts of the Saviour. As we pray for the elect as they celebrate the scrutinies and for all who are to receive sacraments of initiation, let us the baptised undertake a serious examination of life and celebrate the sacrament of God's mercy before Easter.
