# **Easter Sunday**

With great joy we celebrate the Resurrection Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We hear from the Gospel of Mark at the Easter Vigil that the women on arriving at the tomb found that the stone at the entrance of the tomb had already been rolled back. Fear and shock must have been replaced by an indescribable joy when they heard the words of the young man in the white robe, "There is no need for alarm. You are looking for Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified: he has risen, he is not here" (Mk 16:5). It is of crucial importance to believe in the Resurrection. It is not possible to be a Christian and not believe in the Resurrection. In the Resurrection Jesus defeats sin and death. St Paul tells us that when we were baptised in Christ we were baptised in his death. In baptism we joined Christ in death and as he was raised from the dead, so we are to live a new life. This new life is the Christian way of life.

I want to express grateful thanks for all the work and preparation that went into Holy Week. It was wonderful to have so many people at Mass and Confession in Lent and participating in the Easter Triduum. Sincere thanks for your faith and devotion to the Lord. On behalf of Fr. David, Dcn. Andy and myself may you have a blessed Easter and may your loved ones be abundantly blessed with the joy of the Risen Lord!
