# **GROWTH IN THE SPIRIT**

This Sunday's gospel contains two parables (stories to explain a deeper truth) about the Kingdom of God. We must be ready and anticipating something greater than ourselves and something that can only be possible with the help of the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit plants seed in our hearts with the potential for enormous growth. We are required to be open to that growth and to remove any distractions that could pull us away from God's purpose for our lives. We are often tempted by pride, by winning the admiration of others, by being critical of others' lack of growth or motivation.

There are some very tangible examples of opportunities for growth happening in our parish at the moment: Our third online Alpha course, into its fifth week, is already seeing a veritable harvest. Our guests have come with open hearts and minds seeking that the seed of faith moves from head to heart and that they will be drawn deeper into an intimate relationship with Jesus Christ. In a short space of time participants are experiencing what it is to be community and part of the Kingdom which is both present and to be anticipated. We invite the Holy Spirit to be present in our meetings and we have been blessed by signs of growth both in our guests and in our team. The culture of Alpha is such that those who have experienced the journey are approached and asked to come back and help and be part of the team for the next course. We have truly seen several past participants who have returned in the way and have grown in confidence and become those mustard plants.

This week we recommenced our Restored Lives Course for those who have been through separation or divorce. People are welcomed from any faith background or none but what the course does offer is to plant the seed of hope back into their hearts to enable those who feel broken and lost to realise that restoration is possible and that there is 'a future and a hope'. 'Nobody can go back and start a new beginning, but anyone can start today and make a new ending'.

Called and Gifted continues to flourish: The Spirit plants charisms / gifts into our lives that are there to be used for the good of others. The Spirit plants, the Spirit ripens and the Spirit brings forth. The Holy Spirit plants but we have to be open to growth and the means of promoting that growth. We have to prepare the soil of our hearts.

We have just completed 'The Year of the Word' and there have been several opportunities within our Diocese and beyond to plant and root God's word into our hearts and let it flourish. A number of parishioners have attended the readers workshops and experienced what it is to receive, ponder and proclaim the Living Word.

The farmer sowed the seed by day and allowed it to mature and flourish overnight. A spiritual director taught and advised me to spend the last few minutes of my waking day pondering scripture or spiritual reading as overnight that would bear fruit; wise words and so much more productive then going to sleep on Google!

We have just moved into the 'Year of the Eucharist' and Bishop Philip has encouraged us all to return to regular reception and adoration of the Eucharist to plant that seed of Jesus present within us. We are all encouraged to bring people back to Communion, to make Jesus present in our lives and the lives of others and to truly pray 'Thy Kingdom Come'.

Thank you to Father Nick for helping out this weekend and next. Good to have him with us, and in his 53rd year of Ordained Priesthood. The weeks after that are still to be planned.

As mentioned last week please see the note elsewhere about our First Holy Communion Masses. This impacts on me with extra Masses over the weekend (so be patient with me!); it also means no 'usual' Saturday Mass on the 26th June, 3<sup>rd</sup> July and 24<sup>th</sup> July. These Saturday morning Masses will be for First Holy Communion Masses only. Also, of course, no confessions on those days. Sorry but needs must.

Thank you to those people who have come forward and willing to monitor/operate the Streaming in both churches. We need many, many more ..... so please do come forward (Role: boot up; go live; operate the camera shots [using an 8 button key fob]; switch off and reschedule the Mass for a week's time!!).

We wait in anticipation for tomorrow's  $(14^{th})$ announcement about the 21st target for total opening up! We will wait until we know exactly what the Government allows and then decide what is best for us. We will be looking for Altar Servers (probably only 2 at each Mass); possibility of opening up for a couple of hours most weekdays (with Adoration if we have volunteer adorers). Need to look at refreshments after Mass ...... I think we are all keen/'desperate' to spend time together socially.

We are moving into a better place, but still think of others, and remember: if you suspect you have been near someone with coronavirus, or are not feeling well yourself, stay at home and certainly DO NOT mix with others; also refrain from coming to church. I am now doing a 'Lateral Flow Test' twice a week. Are you? Keep safe! Be safe!


