A few words from Father Vincent ..... more than usual!...... Thank you to Father Nick for again presiding this time at the 6.15pm & 9am Masses this weekend. Thank you to all who are supporting me during Father Ansel's absence. Welcome to Sister Ann who will be making the Annual Mission Appeal.

This coming Friday we say 'farewell' to Anne Wheeler as Parish Secretary. She will be much missed by all who have had dealings with the Office, parishioners, non-parishioners and trades people alike; even more so by me! Thankfully, for us as a faith community, Anne remains a parishioner. There is more I wish to say about Anne in gratitude for what she has done and who she is .............. but will leave that for a later date!

We welcome Anna Smyllie who has been appointed as Anne's successor. This past week, and this coming week, Anna and Anne have been working together for a seamless transition!

Please pray for **Father Paul Leonard's mother** who died last Saturday evening ( $31^{st}$  July). May she rest in peace. Paul was with her when she died. We pray for Fr Paul, his father and the family.

The results of the Parish 'Post-Covid Survey' is on the website. We have put it on the site in a 'pie-chart' format (thanks to Lorraine Swann). There is the full version (25 slides) and a short version (12 slides). Remember we did the survey to enable us as a Parish to hear where people are in terms of faith, life and religious practice. This helps the Senior Leadership Team, the EST and others to reflect on where we are going and what it is we need to pick up and respond to as Parish. There are many challenges but also a lot of consolation and hope. As slide 15 shows us, God has been working during the pandemic (53.4% say their relationship with God is stronger; and 13.6% say it is weaker)! Slide 13 shows that 34.8% sustained their faith by prayer and 42% with online activities/resources; 64.6% said their faith was 'strong' (slide 14). There are challenges ahead as to how we can be 'Church', assist people in their faith, and help people in their journey with and to God. Have a look at the survey. What does it say to you? What insights does it give you? If the survey conveys something you think is essential for us to 'note', 'pick up' or 'pursue' do let me know.

Ongoing thanks to the **Church Opening Working Group** who have enabled us to open a little more without risking safety. As the weeks go by we will monitor and continue to open up more and more (numbers are climbing.....which is great). I encourage you to **wear masks** for the sake of others (unless you have a health issue). We can hum/sing under our masks (if we can remember the hymns!!). We are looking at re-introducing **Altar Servers**, **Readers** (see elsewhere), **Mass Co-ordinators**, **Welcomers etc**. If you are willing to pick up these ministries please do contact me or the Parish Office.

Father Ansel, thankfully, is getting stronger and stronger. We hope to see him before he departs for Rome in September (we will have a collection for him the weekend of the  $21^{st}/22^{nd}$ ). Father Johnpromise will be arriving at the end of August, just before my holiday. Sadly we say farewell to Sister Valentina Stilo (Verbum Dei) who has been in the Parish for about 9 years as University Chaplain; also to Kaitlin Gilday (FOCUS Missionary to the Uni). Sr Val has gone to Rome to study theology; Kaitlin returns this week to the USA to take up teaching.

We thank them both and wish them well. Have a good weekend and **thank you for reading this**. **Vincent H**
